Historical Profile



iMpact Christian Church, A Kingdom Agenda Fellowship, was founded as a satellite church by Pastor Keith L. Moore and conducted its first worship service on November 14, 2010, in Montgomery, Alabama. Pastor Moore was serving a senior pastor in a central Alabama (Morning Star Baptist Church, Clanton, Alabama, when he was inspired by the Holy Spirit to initiate a vision of 'many churches within the church'. iMpact was established as a third worship service in furtherance of the vision as the Lord allowed placement of sons of the ministry to support multi-site ministry. The vision was to create a Kingdom focused fellowship, hence 'many churches within the church', of diverse ministries/churches of like vision through church plants of multiple sites of iMpact Christian Church and covenant connection.



Historical Profile

At its founding, iMpact was comprised of 11 members, including its Founding Family, Deleta M. Moore, Kezia L. Moore, Zipporah J. Moore and Bishop Keith L. Moore, and two key supporters who came by covenant connection; LaGora S. Harrell and Maude Moore. To date iMpact has a fully functioning Presbytery comprised of more than ordained elders and minsters of the gospel well versed in all nine sacerdotal functions, leading an anchor congregation. Kingdom Agenda Fellowship has planted many covenant ministries, and even more ministries/churches are in covenant. (In house @124 in later session)

iMpact is a founding member-church of Timothy's House International Fellowship (Now Promise Assembly), Presiding Primate Apostle Wales Williams Jr, Established 2011 where Bishop was consecrated in August 2012.

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The 5 Solae – Foundation of Protestantism



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#1

Sola Gratia (Grace alone)

Salvation is the free gift of God to man. It is given by God's Grace alone and not through any merit on the part of the Christian.

GRACE = God's Riches At Christ's Expense.

For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Ephesians 2:8-9 (KJV).



The 5 Solae – Foundation of Protestantism 2. Sola Fide



(Faith alone)

We are judged righteous in the sight of God purely on the basis of our faith. The atoning sacrifice of Christ leads to righteousness being imputed to us as sinners through a legal declaration by God. This is often stated as <u>Justification by faith alone</u>. There is a clear distinction between <u>Justification</u> and <u>Sanctification</u>, the latter being the growth in holiness arising from the work of the Holy Spirit in the Christian.

FAITH = Forsaking All I Trust Him.

But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for the just shall live by faith.

Galatians 3:11 (KJV).



The 5 Solae – Foundation of Protestantism 3.



Solus Christus (Christ alone)

Christ is the one Mediator between God and man and our salvation is accomplished only through His death and resurrection.

For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; 1 Timothy 2:5 (KJV).

In addition, every believer is a priest before God, with immediate access to him for the forgiveness of sins. This is known as the doctrine of the <u>Priesthood of all believers</u>. It was classically articulated by Martin Luther, but <u>Protestants point to 1 Peter 2:9</u>. But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should show forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light."



The 5 Solae – Foundation of 4. Protestantism Sola Scriptura



(Scripture alone)

Scripture alone is the only infallible source of divine revelation and the final authority for matters of faith and practice. *Sola Scriptura* does not mean that all truth is contained in the Bible (for example the Nicene Creed is widely accepted and recited within orthodox Christianity), but rather that all mankind needs to know for salvation is contained within its pages.

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

5.

Soli Deo Gloria

(To the glory of God alone)

Every aspect of the Christian life is to be seen as giving glory to God.

If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

1 Peter 4:11 (KJV).







Section 1. The Bible Is The Authoritative Word Of God. We hold the Bible, the Holy Scriptures of the Old and New Testament, to be the inerrant and infallible inspired Word of God and the only perfect rule for faith, doctrine, and conduct (2 Tim. 3:16; Heb. 1:1-3; Jn. 1:1-14).



Section 2. The Bible Governs The Church. We hold the Bible to be supreme in all matters governing this Church in keeping with the Spirit of the authority of Christ that is established through His gifted Headship of the Pastor assisted by elders to rule a local Church (Mt. 28:18-20; Acts 20:17, 28; Eph. 4:7,8,11-16; Heb. 13:17).

Section 3. Voluntary Membership. We hold as Scriptural and fundamental that form of Church government that is a voluntary Church membership, with this local Church being sovereign under Jesus Christ who is the head of the Church (Colossians 1:8). Therefore, it is absolutely essential that each individual member is conscientious to please God, of their own accord and conviction, and personally believe that they should request to join this local Church Body of "members in particular" (1 Corinthians 12:18, 27).



Section 4. The Apostles' Creed. We hold to the fundamental values of the faith and confessions of the historic Christian Church, particularly the Apostles' Creed, but also to the sovereignty of the Word of God over all creedal interpretations. The Apostles' Creed, commonly called the oldest summary of Christian doctrine now extant, and one which the Roman, Greek and Protestant Churches all accept, originated, as is agreed, as early as the fourth century. The Apostles' Creed says:





"I believe in God the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth; And in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Ghost, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried: he descended into hell; the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and sitteth on the right hand of God the Father Almighty, from thence he shall come to judge the quick and the dead.





I believe in the Holy Ghost; the holy catholic (universal) church; the communion of saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting. Amen."





Section 5. The Unity Of Faith. We hold it basic that every Christian should "Endeavor to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace...Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ" (Ephesians 4:3, 13).
