#### The TENTH...

- Ma'aser tithe, tenth part, tenth part,
  - tithe, payment of a tenth part



## A Historical Progression of the Tithe Before the Law





The meaning of the law of First Mention: The Law of First Mention may be said to be the principle that requires one to go to that portion of the Scriptures where a doctrine is..

- (1) mentioned for the first time and to
- (2) study the first occurrence of the same in order
- (3) to get the fundamental inherent meaning of that doctrine.

(4th of 8-Laws of Biblical Interpretation)

And the king of Sodom went out to meet him after his return from the slaughter of Chedorlaomer, and of the kings that were with him, at the valley of Shaveh, which is the king's dale. And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.

And he blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth: And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all.



For this **Melchisedec**, **king of Salem**, priest of the most high God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him; (v1)

To whom also Abraham gave a <u>tenth part of all</u>; first being by interpretation <u>King of righteousness</u>, and after that also <u>King of Salem</u>, which is, <u>King of peace</u>; (v2)



Without father, without mother, without descent, having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; but made like unto the Son of God; abideth a priest continually. (v3)

Now consider how great this man was, unto whom even the patriarch Abraham gave the tenth of the spoils. (v4)

And verily they that are of the sons of Levi, who receive the office of the priesthood, have a commandment to take tithes of the people according to the law, that is, of their brethren, though they come out of the loins of Abraham: (v5) But he whose descent is not counted from them received tithes of Abraham, and blessed him that had the promises.

But he whose descent <u>is not counted from them</u> received tithes of Abraham, and blessed him that had the promises. (v6) And without all contradiction the <u>less is blessed of the better</u>. (v7) <u>And here men that die receive tithes; but there he receiveth them, of whom it is witnessed that he liveth</u>. (v8)



And as I may so say, Levi also, who receiveth tithes, payed tithes in Abraham. (v9)

For he was yet in the loins of his father, when Melchisedec met him. (v10)



#### **Principles:**

- 1. The blessing PRECEDES the Tithe.
- 2. Your are blessed because of COVENANT CONNECTION.
- 3. A blessed life HONORS God.
- 4. Tithing is not MATERIAL but SPIRITUAL! The Anointing!



#### **Principles:**

- 6. Tithe is COMMANDED LAW.
- 7. The ANOINTING is superior to THE LAW.
- 8. Giving is ETERNAL but SYSTEM ORIENTED.



# A Historical Progression of the Tithe Old Testament & Law



- The Levitical priesthood was never permanent (Hebrews 7:11).
- The death of Christ put an end to the Old Covenant and the Levitical priesthood, as evidenced by the rending of the temple veil (Matthew 27:51).
- Now Jesus Himself serves as the believer's Great High Priest (Hebrews 4:14), called according to the order of Melchizedek, not of Levi (Hebrews 7:11-17).
- Through His death and resurrection, we have access to God's presence, where we can freely enjoy Him forever (Hebrews 6:19-20).



### A Historical Progression of the Tithe

- Old Testament The tithe was a requirement of the Law (Israelites) 10% of crops, livestock to the tabernacle/temple
- Old Testament Law required multiple tithes one for the Levites, one for the use of the temple and the feasts, one for the poor of the land (Actually about\*23.3 percent.)

(Leviticus 27:30; Numbers 18:26; Deuteronomy 14:24; 2 Chronicles 31:5).



### The Levitical System - Leviticus 27:26-34

Only the firstling of the beasts, which should be the LORD'S firstling, no man shall sanctify it; whether it be ox, or sheep: it is the LORD'S. (26) And if it be of an unclean beast, then he shall redeem it according to thine estimation, and shall add a fifth part of it thereto: or if it be not redeemed, then it shall be sold according to thy estimation.



### The Levitical System - Leviticus 27:26-34

(27) Notwithstanding no devoted thing, that a man shall devote unto the LORD of all that he hath, both of man and beast, and of the field of his possession, shall be sold or redeemed: every devoted thing is most holy unto the LORD. (28) None devoted, which shall be devoted of men, shall be redeemed; but shall surely be put to death.

### The Levitical System - Leviticus 27:20:34

(29) And all the tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land, or of the fruit of the tree, is the LORD'S: it is holy unto the LORD.(30) And if a man will at all redeem ought of his tithes, he shall add thereto the <u>fifth part</u> thereof. (31) And concerning the tithe of the <u>herd</u>, or of the <u>flock</u>, even of whatsoever passeth under the rod, the tenth shall be holy unto the LORD. (32)

### The Levitical System - Leviticus 27:26-34

He shall not search whether it be good or bad, neither shall he change it: and if he change it at all, then both it and the change thereof shall be holy; it shall not be redeemed. (33)

These are the commandments, which the LORD commanded Moses for the children of Israel in mount Sinai. (34)



#### A Historical Progression of the Tithe

 Old Testament - Even from the days of your fathers ye are gone away from mine ordinances, and have not kept them. Return unto me, and I will return unto you, saith the LORD of hosts. But ye said, Wherein shall we return? (7) Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings. (8) Ye are cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, even this whole nation. (Malachi 3:9) ring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts,... 32 5/5/24



#### A Historical Progression of the Tithe

 Old Testament - if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. (10) And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts. (11) And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the LORD of hosts. (Malachi 3:12)

#### **Principles:**

- 1. The LAW and LEVITICAL SYSTEM was TEMPORARY.
- 2. CHRIST FULFILLED the Law.
- 3. We must deal in PRINCIPLE vs. LAW.
- 4. Tithe HONOR GOD.



#### **Principles:**

- 6. Tithe was given for COVENANT RELEASE.
- 7. Tithe is for FOUNDATIONAL PROTECTION & GUARDED PROVISION.



# A Historical Progression of the Tithe New Testament & Grace



#### WARNING - Law vs. Grace

- The Levitical priesthood was never permanent (<u>Hebrews 7:11</u>).
- The death of Christ put an end to the Old Covenant and the Levitical priesthood, as evidenced by the rending of the temple veil (<u>Matthew 27:51</u>).
- Now Jesus Himself serves as the believer's Great High Priest (Hebrews 4:14), called according to the order of Melchizedek, not of Levi (Hebrews 7:11–17).
- Through His death and resurrection, we have access to God's presence, where we can freely enjoy Him forever (<u>Hebrews 6:19–20</u>).



- New Testament ....tithe is not mentioned, but it has been applied as foundational or a minimum of appropriate giving by believers.
- New Testament believers should ask God for wisdom, and a right heart to support the vision and work of the Kingdom! (2 Corinthians 9:6-15) (Malachi 3 compared)



But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. (6) Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver. (7) And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work: (8)



New Testament Malachi 3 compared)

(As it is written, He hath dispersed abroad; he hath given to the poor: his righteousness remaineth for ever. (9) Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness;) (10) Being enriched in every thing to all bountifulness, which causeth through us thanksgiving to God. (11)

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New Testament Malachi 3 compared)

For the administration of this service not only supplieth the want of the saints, but is abundant also by many thanksgivings unto God; (12) Whiles by the experiment of this ministration they glorify God for your professed subjection unto the gospel of Christ, and for your liberal distribution unto them, and unto all men; (13) And by their prayer for you, which long after you for the exceeding grace of God in you. (14) Thanks be unto God for his unspeakable gift. (15)

#### **Principles:**

- 1. GRACE is the set of "BOOKENDS TO THE LAW".
- 2. CHRIST released GRACE upon the Believer.
- 3. By GRACE, we affect the RELEASE OF BLESSING in our lives.
- 4. Giving must be APPROACHED WITH PROPER ATTITUDE OF HEART.
- 5. GIVING by GRACE gives SUFFICIENCY for all MINISTRY NEEDS.

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


#### **DEFINITION**
